The new #TransparencyRegulation came into application!"

The new Regulation on the transparency and sustainability of the EU risk assessment in the food chain aims at increasing the transparency of the EU risk assessment in the food chain, on strengthening the reliability, objectivity and independence of the studies used by European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), and revisiting the governance of EFSA in order to ensure its long-term sustainability. The regulation was developed in response to a European Citizens' Initiative on pesticides and the findings of the review of the General Food Law Regulation that was completed in January 2018.



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#EUandMyFood

EFSA, the EU Member States and the European Commission are jointly launching a campaign called #EUandMyFood. The aim is to remind EU citizens how we all benefit from the European food safety system that was created in 2002 under the General Food Law." EUandMyFood is about having safe and nutritious food in Europe that we can trust. It's about having respect for the health of our animals and how we treat them. And it's about being responsible for our environment – the soil, water and air – which sustain the food and feed crops that we and our animals, respectively, eat" stated Dr Url. The EUandMyFood campaign is being jointly promoted by EFSA and national food safety authorities in the EU Member States with the support of the European Commission's Health and Food Safety Directorate General.

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How to reach people with food safety information

According to a 2019 Special Eurobarometer, people living in the EU have a high level of awareness about food safety issues. Awareness of different types of food safety risks varies from country to country, but in general people have heard about many different topics related to food safety, including additives, a wide range of contaminants, food hygiene and food poisoning, allergies and more. Nina McGrath from EUFIC in this article proposes how to reach people with correct information and the contribution that FS4EU could provide on this point.

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Exploring the Potential of ToxCast Data in Supporting Read-Across for **Evaluation of Food Chemical Safety**

The study explores if high-throughput screening data can be applied in toxicological read-across for food-related compounds. Focusing upon estrogenicity for proof of principle, exploratory case studies are presented covering 2 chemical families: the paraben-gallate grouping and pyranone-type compounds.

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Dual food quality: Commission releases study on sensory differences in food products

The European Commission just released a study conducted by #JRC on sensory differences in food products. That's the 2nd part of an EU-wide quality comparison of food products marketed under the same branding.




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The International Year of Fruits and Vegetables (IYFV-2021) Background Paper

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Eating seasonal and local: EUFIC launches 1st ever Europe-wide interactive fruit and vegetables map

The European Food Information Council (EUFIC) launched today the first-ever Europe-wide fruit and vegetables seasonality interactive map. In the context of the 2021 International Year of Fruits and Vegetables proclaimed by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), the new map provides accurate and science-based information to guide consumers in making healthy and more sustainable choices.

The tool combines data from established national sources and features over 200 seasonal fruits and vegetables, covers 24 countries, and includes the six European climate regions.

Circularity in mixed crops and livestock farming systems with emphasis on climate change mitigation and adaptation

The four ERA-NETs SusAn (Sustainable Animal Production Systems), FACCE ERA-GAS (Monitoring and Mitigation of Greenhouse Gases from Agriculture and Silviculture), SusCrop (Sustainable Crop Production) and ICT-AGRI-FOOD have coordinated and aligned efforts in areas of mutual interest and established a joint transnational funding initiative in the field of agricultural greenhouse gas (GHG) research, focusing on circularity in mixed crops and livestock farming systems with emphasis on climate change mitigation and adaptation.

This Call is about research on (re-) integration of crop and livestock farming systems with the aim to enhance circularity between these systems and thereby improve the sustainability of farms.

EXPAND - The SmartAgriHubs Community Network


